Questions for Daily / Weekly Discussions

1. What verse or passage from this week's reading stood out to you, and why?
2. How can we apply the lessons from this week's scripture to our daily lives?
3. What challenges or encouragements did you experience while reflecting on this week's reading?
4. How does this passage shape or deepen our understanding of God's character?
5. How can we use the lessons from this scripture to serve our community?

Items for the Bible-Reading Project

1. Bibles and Study Materials**

- Bibles for Different Ages
 - Adult/Teen Bibles: Standard translations like NRSV, NBV21
 - Children's Bibles: Illustrated or simplified versions
- Memory Verse Cards to share with children and adults.
- Writing Supplies: Notebooks, pens, pencils, and highlighters for note-taking and journaling.
- Art Supplies for Kids: Crayons, markers, coloured paper, glue, and stickers for Bible-related crafts.
- Whiteboard or Flipchart: For writing discussion points, key verses, or summaries of readings.
- Prayer Journals: Booklets for participants to record their reflections and prayer points.

2. Service and Outreach Care Package Materials:

- Hygiene kits: Soap, shampoo, toothbrushes, etc.
- Food items: Non-perishables or snack packs.
- Encouragement notes or Bible verse cards.
- Clothing Donations: Collected gently used or new clothes for those in need.
- Gardening Tools: For environmental projects like planting trees or flowers.
- First Aid Kit: For safety during events.

3. Children's Activities

- Craft Supplies: Items like pipe cleaners, beads, and construction paper for interactive crafts.
- Games and Props: Bean bags, balls, or other equipment for fun activities.
- Storybooks and Visual Aids: For engaging children in Bible stories during the event.
- Kids' Prizes or Giveaways: Small toys, stickers, or colouring books as takeaways.
